Key Idea of the Week:

God has left his fingerprints all over creation. It is possible to know God from what He has made, but He went beyond this to reveal Himself by coming in the flesh as Jesus Christ. How does Jesus Christ fulfill God's revelation of Himself to humankind?

Discussion Guide:

Pray for God to soften your hearts and speak to you as you open His Word together.

Read Job 38:3-36.

Discuss

What was your favourite image in this passage. Why?

In your life, what aspect of God's creation is most impressive to you? Explain.

List the qualities of God that can be understood strictly from creation's witness.

Can we tell enough about His ways to be held accountable for our actions when we sin?

Think about the life of Jesus. How did He put flesh on the qualities of God that were evident in creation? What else about God did He reveal?

Why do some people deny the existence of God as creator? What does it imply for them?

If God can be seen in creation but finished the revealing of Himself by coming in the flesh, does this change how we demonstrate our love to each other?

In light of this, what is going to be different for you this Christmas? What commitments are you willing to make right now?

Pray for courage to act on what you've learned this week and for any requests that may have been raised by members of the group.
